RESOLUTION NO. 2022 - 18

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT
CHIEF EXECUTIVE, MAYOR MARY MARILYN DG.
LAMBINO, REPRESENTING THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT
UNIT OF MANGALDAN, PANGASINAN, TO ENTER INTO A
MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) WITH THE
DEPARTMENT OF INFORMATION AND
COMMUNICATIONS TECHNOLOGY FOR THE ADOPTION
AND IMPLEMENTATION OF THE iBPLS: BUSINESS
PERMIT MODULE.

WHEREAS, the Department of Information, Communications and
Technology (DICT) has launched the Electronic Business permits and Licensing
System, a cloud-based software that would enable LGU's and their constituents to
file, apply and process business, building permits and other business transactions
electronically;

WHEREAS, part of President Rodrigo Duterte's 10-socioeconomic agenda
is to increase competitiveness and the Ease of Doing Business by moving towards
automation;

WHEREAS, in compliance of Section 11 (c) of the R.A. 11032 also known as Ease of Doing Business and Efficient Government Services Delivery Act of 2018, cities/municipalities are mandated to automate their business permitting and licensing system or set up an electronic BOSS within a period of three (3) years upon the effectivity of this Act for a more efficient business registration processes. Cities/Municipalities with electronic BOSS shall develop electronic versions of licenses, clearances, permits, certifications or authorizations with the level of authority, which may be printed by businesses in the convenience of their offices;

WHEREAS, with the need to improve the services, the Local Government of Mangaldan embraced the electronic Business Permit and Licensing Systems, introduced by DICT. This will simplify the Municipality's system of governance and delivery of services in the area of business permitting and licensing, and provide the mechanism for efficient collections, reporting and monitoring of businesses of the local government unit;

WHEREAS, the overriding consideration on the mandates of R.A. No. 11032 to simplify procedures and the need to adapt with the new normal, the municipality was moved to innovate. Digital governance proves an effective tool to address people's concerns, provide solutions to continue operate and enhance the system of service delivery;

WHEREAS, Section 444, (vi) of R.A. 7160, the Municipal Mayor shall, upon authorization of the Sangguniang Bayan, represent the municipality in all its business transactions and sign on its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations, and such other documents made pursuant to law or ordinance;

WHEREFORE, on motion of Councilor Atty. Fernando Juan A. Cabrera, duly seconded by all members of Sangguniang Bayan:

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved that the Sangguniang Bayan of Mangaldan, Pangasinan authorizes the Local Chief Executive, Mayor Mary Marilyn DG. Lambino, representing the Local Government Unit of Mangaldan, Pangasinan to enter into a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the Department of Information and Communications Technology for the adoption and implementation of the iBPLS: Business Permit Module;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that copies of this resolution be furnished the Department of Information and Communications Technology through Hon. Emmanuel Rey R. Caintic, Acting Secretary, DICT Building, Carlos P. Garcia Avenue, Diliman, Quezon City, the MLGOO, Mrs. Romarie P. Soriano, the Commission on Audit through Mrs. Marina P. De Guzman, Audit Team Leader, the Office of the Municipal Mayor, Hon. Mary Marilyn DG. Lambino and all other authorities concerned for their information and favorable action.
