RESOLUTION NO. 2020 – 160

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE LOCAL CHIEF
EXECUTIVE, HON. MARY MARILYN DG. LAMBINO TO
ADOPT AND IMPLEMENT UNDER EXPERIMENTAL
SCHEME THE SEQUENCE OF THE NUMBER CODING OF
DAGUPAN CITY FROM JUNE 1 TO 15, 2020.

WHEREAS, His Excellency President Rodrigo Roa Duterte issued
Proclamation Nos. 922 and 929, “Declaring a State of Public Health Emergency
throughout the Philippines” and “Declaring State of Calamity throughout the
Philippines due to Corona Virus Disease 2019”, respectively in connection with the
onslaught of Corona Virus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) which is now considered by
World Health Organization (WHO) as pandemic;

WHEREAS, Section 16 of R.A. 7160, otherwise known as the Local
Government Code of 1991 provides “Section 16. *General Welfare*. - Every local
government unit shall exercise the powers expressly granted, those necessarily
implied therefrom, as well as powers necessary, appropriate, or incidental for its
efficient and effective governance, and those which are essential to the promotion
of the general welfare. Within their respective territorial jurisdictions, local
government units shall ensure and support, among other things, the preservation
and enrichment of culture, promote health and safety, enhance the right of the

people to a balanced ecology, encourage and support the development of appropriate and self-reliant scientific and technological capabilities, improve public morals, enhance economic prosperity and social justice, promote full employment among their residents, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants”;

WHEREAS, various Memorandum Circulars and Advisories were issued by the Department of Interior and local Government where the emphasis in promoting the health and safety of their residents, maintaining peace and order and preserving the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants is placed on the role of the Local Government Units;

WHEREAS, every Local Government Units are mandated to take precautionary measures supported by appropriate legislations so as to have force and effect of the law for its effective implementation;

WHEREAS, the City of Dagupan has enacted an Ordinance No. 2204-2020 entitled Ordinance Regulating the Operation of Private Vehicles within the Territorial Jurisdiction of the City of Dagupan during the State Public Health emergency by imposing a Number Coding so as to restrict or regulate the movement of people during this period of uncertainties wrought about by COVID-19;





WHEREAS, the Municipality of Mangaldan, Pangasinan is adjacent to the City of Dagupan. Both Local Government Units are located at the central part of the 4th District of Pangasinan where most business establishments and other basic health services and other important facilities are situated. Accordingly, the influx of people from different walks of life is expected to happen because of the amenities of the said two (2) LGU’s. As such, the Sangguniang Bayan of Mangaldan, Pangasinan deemed it proper to adopt the sequence of the Number Coding of Dagupan City, where:

Plate Number Ending	Days of the Week
1-2	Monday
3-4	Tuesday
5-6	Wednesday
7-8	Thursday
9-0	Friday

should be followed so as to avoid complications and hassles to motorists coming from the Municipality of Mangaldan, Pangasinan, notwithstanding the fact that the Number Coding Scheme would regulate the incursion of people in public places;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 87 (b) (vi) of the Rules and Regulations Implementing the Local Government Code of 1991, the Municipal Mayor upon authorization by the Sangguniang Bayan, represent the municipality in all business transactions and sign on its behalf all bonds, contracts, and obligations, and such other documents made pursuant to law or ordinance;


WHEREFORE, on joint motion of Councilor Atty. Joseph Emmanuel B. Cera and Councilor Atty. Fernando Juan A. Cabrera duly seconded by all the remaining members present:



RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved that the Sangguniang Bayan of Mangaldan, Pangasinan authorizes the Local Chief Executive, Hon. Mary Marilyn DG. Lambino to Adopt and Implement under Experimental Scheme the Sequence of the Number Coding of Dagupan City from June 1 to 15, 2020;


