
RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE LOCAL CHIEF  
EXECUTIVE, HON. MARY MARILYN DG. LAMBINO, TO  
ENTER INTO A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT ON  
BEHALF OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MANGALDAN WITH  
METRO CLARK WASTE MANAGEMENT CORPORATION.

WHEREAS, the Ecological Social Waste Management Act of 2000 (Republic  
Act 9003) was approved in January 26, 2001 and came into effect on February 16,  
2001....Despite this law, however, poor solid waste management in the Philippines is  
still prevalent;

WHEREAS, one of the major concerns of the Local Government Unit of  
Mangaldan is the problem on poor waste management;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of Mangaldan, Pangasinan has  
previously entered into a Memorandum of Agreement with Metro Clark Management  
Corporation for the service of hauling and disposal of solid wastes of the Municipality  
by virtue of Sangguniang Bayan Resolution No. 2019-213;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit of Mangaldan, Pangasinan focuses its  
concern on waste management so as to comply with the mandate of the national  
government to protect the environment for the welfare of the future generation;



WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 444 (b) (1) (iv) of the Local Government Code of 1991 otherwise known as R.A. 7160, the Municipal Mayor shall, upon the authorization by the Sangguniang Bayan, represent the Municipality in all its business transactions and sign on its all bonds, contracts and obligations, and such other documents made pursuant to law or ordinance;

WHEREFORE, on the motion of Councilor Aldrin O. Soriano duly seconded by the remaining members present:

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved that the Sangguniang Bayan of Mangaldan, Pangasinan authorizes the Local Chief Executive, Hon. Mary Marilyn DG. Lambino to enter into Memorandum of Agreement on behalf of the Municipality of Mangaldan with Metro Clark Waste Management Corporation;


