RESOLUTION NO. 2021 – 18

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE LOCAL CHIEF  
EXECUTIVE, MAYOR MARY MARILYN DG. LAMBINO TO  
NEGOTIATE WITH ACCREDITED PHARMACEUTICAL  
COMPANIES FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF COVID-19  
VACCINES FOR LGU MANGALDAN TARGET  
BENEFICIARIES BASED ON DOH AND WHO GUIDELINES.

WHEREAS, Section 15 of 1987 Philippine Constitution provides, “the State  
shall protect and promote the right to health of its people”;

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2020, due to the sustained risk of further global  
spread and its serious negative impact on every sector, the WHO declared COVID-  
19 a pandemic;

WHEREAS, as of January 5, 2021, report said that almost 86 million people  
worldwide have been infected with the COVID-19 virus, leaving at least 1.8  
million people dead. In the Philippines there are 478,761 infected Filipinos and  
9,263 deaths;

WHEREAS, nations have partnered up with pharmaceutical companies in a  
race to develop and deploy safe and effective vaccines to combat COVID-19, of

which Pfizer-BioNtech, Moderna and from Oxford University-Astrazeneca were among those currently approved for use;

WHEREAS, the National Task Force (NTF) has assured the Local Government Units that a new law will be passed to further authorize the LGU's emergency procurement of COVID-19 vaccines through multilateral agreement, per Government Procurement Policy Board Resolution No. 03-2020 and Section 5.14 of the Implementing Guidelines of R.A. No. 11494 ("Bayanihan Act");

WHEREAS, Section 16 of RA 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, the Municipality has the implied power to do all things necessary, appropriate, or incidental to govern efficient and effectively, promote general welfare, promote health and safety, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenient of their inhabitants;

WHEREFORE, on motion of Councilor Dr. Joselito G. Quinto duly seconded by all the members present:

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved that the Sangguniang Bayan of Mangaldan, Pangasinan authorizes the Local Chief Executive, Mayor Mary Marilyn DG. Lambino to negotiate with Accredited Pharmaceutical Companies for the procurement of COVID-19 vaccines for LGU Mangaldan Target Beneficiaries based on DOH and WHO Guidelines;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that copies of this resolution be furnished the MLGOO, Mrs. Romarie P. Soriano, the Commission on Audit through Mrs. Marina P. De Guzman, Audit Team Leader, the Office of the Municipal Mayor, Hon. Mary Marilyn DG. Lambino and all other authorities concerned for their information and favorable action.


