RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING LGU MANGALDAN TO
AVAIL OF DEVELOPMENT BANK OF THE PHILIPPINES
ELECTRONIC PAYMENT AND COLLECTION SYSTEM
(EPCS); AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE LOCAL CHIEF
EXECUTIVE, MARY MARILYN DG. LAMBINO, TO ENTER
INTO A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING AND/OR
MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE
MUNICIPAL GOVERNMENT OF MANGALDAN WITH
DEVELOPMENT BANK OF THE PHILIPPINES FOR AN
ELECTRONIC PAYMENT AND COLLECTION SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, the Development Bank of the Philippines (DBP) is a country's
premier financing institution which actively support projects and programs which
are primarily directed to social services and community development;

WHEREAS, the widespread use of the internet and emergence of
technological innovations make digital/electronic payment more accessible and
affordable, thereby propelling the progressive shift towards a cash-lite economy;

WHEREAS, with the onset of the COVID-19 global pandemic, the shift towards digital payment has become an imperative as physical distancing rules become the norm under the new economy environment;

WHEREAS, using digital/electronic payments with due care and vigilance, people reduce the need for mobility and prevent health risks from face-to-face and over the counter financial transaction. Further, COVID-19 crisis has led to an increase in the use of electronic payment, as people prefer safe and contactless method of transaction;

WHEREFORE, on motion of Councilor Atty. Fernando Juan A. Cabrera, duly seconded by other members present:

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved that the Sangguniang Bayan of Mangaldan, Pangasinan authorizes LGU Mangaldan to avail of Development Bank of the Philippines Electronic Payment and Collection System (EPCS); and further authorize the Local Chief Executive, Mary Marilyn DG. Lambino, to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding and/or Memorandum of Agreement on behalf of the Municipal Government of Mangaldan with Development Bank of the Philippines for an Electronic Payment and Collection System;


