RESOLUTION APPROVING OF THE DEVOLUTION TRANSITION PLAN (DTP) 2022-2024 OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT (LGU) OF MANGALDAN, PANGASINAN.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article II, Section 25 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution, the State shall ensure the autonomy of local government;

WHEREAS, it is hereby declared the policy of the State that the territorial and political subdivisions of the State shall enjoy genuine and meaningful local autonomy to enable them to attain their fullest development as self-reliant communities and make them more effective partners in the attainment of national goals. Toward this end, the State shall provide for a more responsive and accountable local government structure instituted through a system of decentralization whereby local government units shall be given more powers, authority, responsibilities, and resources;

WHEREAS, Section 3 of the Local Government Code of 1991 provides for the Operative Principles of Decentralization. Accordingly, the vesting of duty, responsibility and accountability in local government units shall be accompanied with provision for reasonably adequate resources to discharge the powers and X4

effectively carry out their functions; hence, they shall have the powers to create and broaden their own sources of revenue and the right to a just share in national taxes and an equitable share in the proceeds of the utilization and development of the national wealth within their respective areas;

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 138, Series of 2021, orders the full devolution of functions, services and facilities by the national government to local government units not later than the end of FY 2024. These shall include those devolved responsibilities indicated in Section 17 of RA 7160 and in other existing laws which subsequently devolved functions of the national government to local government units. These fully devolved responsibilities shall be funded from the share of the LGUs in the proceeds of the national taxes and other local revenues;

WHEREAS, Department of Budget and Management (DBM) and Department of Interior and Local Government (DILG) Joint Memorandum Circular (JMC) No. 2021.01 dated August 11, 2021 requires all LGUs to prepare their Devolution Transition Plan (DTP) to ensure a strategic perspective and systematic and coherent actions towards their full assumption of devolved functions and services starting in Fiscal Year (FY) 2022;

WHEREAS, the Office of the Municipal Mayor has endorsed to the Sangguniang Bayan for consideration the Devolution Transition Plan 2022-2024 of the Local Government Unit of Mangaldan, Pangasinan;

WHEREAS, after careful review, deliberation and discussion with the presence of the Municipal Planning and Development Coordinator, the same Sangguniang Bayan found that everything indicated in the said Devolution Transition Plan (DTP) has conformed with the mandate set forth by law in the implementation of full devolution of functions, services and facilities by the national government to local government;

WHEREFORE, on joint motion of Councilor Atty. Joseph Emmanuel B. Cera and Councilor Atty. Fernando Juan A. Cabrera, and duly seconded by all other members present:

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved that the Sangguniang Bayan of Mangaldan, Pangasinan approves the Devolution Transition Plan (DTP) 2022-2024 of the Local Government Unit (LGU) of Mangaldan, Pangasinan;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that copies of this resolution be furnished the Office of the Provincial Governor through Hon. Governor Amado "Pogi" I. Espino III, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan through Hon. Vice Governor Mark Ronald DG. Lambino, Presiding Officer, the MLGOO, Mrs. Romarie P. Soriano, the Commission on Audit through Mrs. Marina P. De Guzman, Audit Team Leader, the MPDC, Mrs. Milagros J.
