RESOLUTION NO. 2021 – 82

RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE SANGGUNIANG  
KABATAAN FEDERATION OF MANGALDAN FOR BAGGING  
SECOND PLACE OUT OF NINE LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNIT  
PARTICIPANTS IN THE COUNTRY IN THE SK YOUNIFIED 2.0  
PROGRAM PROJECT GRANT COMPETITION CONDUCTED  
BY THE NATIONAL MOVEMENT OF YOUNG LEGISLATORS  
IN PARTNERSHIP WITH THE YOUNG SOUTHEAST ASIAN  
LEADERS INITIATIVE AND THE UNITED STATES  
GOVERNMENT ALUMNI ASSOCIATION NEGROS  
OCCIDENTAL.

WHEREAS, Section 13, Article II of the 1987 Constitution declares that the  
State recognizes the vital role of the youth in nation-building and shall promote and  
protect their physical, moral, spiritual, intellectual, and social well-being, and shall  
inculcate in the youth, patriotism and nationalism and encourage their involvement in  
public and civic affairs;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 8044 or the Young in Nation-Building Act  
defines youth as those persons whose age ranges from fifteen (15) to thirty (30) years  
old;

WHEREAS, RA 10742 or the Sangguniang Kabataan Reform Act of 2015 states that the *Pederasyon ng Sangguniang Kabataan* in municipalities is composed of the Sangguniang Kabataan chairpersons of barangays in the municipality;

WHEREAS, the National Movement of Young Legislators in partnership with the Young Southeast Asian Leaders Initiative and the United States Government Alumni Association in Negros Occidental held the SK YOUNIFIED 2.0 Program;

WHEREAS, the SK YOUNIFIED 2.0's theme is "Youth of the 21st Century (Y21): Development and Empowerment of SKs" allows the participants to understand their strengths and weaknesses, enabling them to collaborate and come up with projects and programs for their respective localities that would advance the cause of the youth during this challenging times;

WHEREAS, the online training and mentoring program includes personal and global leadership management perspectives, emphasizing teamwork and interpersonal skills, greater flexibility, and exposure to solving real-world problems through leadership workshops and group dynamics;

WHEREAS, the online training will not only focus on capability building but will also platform the discussion of critical Projects Programs and Activities for the SK such as the utilization of SK funds, fun and interactive panel discussions on environmental protection, climate change adaptation, disaster risk reduction, and resiliency, youth empowerment and livelihood, health, anti-drug abuse, and health;

WHEREAS, out of 105 SK officials all over the country Mangaldan has five delegates which include the SK Federation President Michael Ervin Lomibao of Barangay Anolid, SK Federation Vice President Aleah Carbonel Velasquez of Barangay Landas, SK Chairperson Joan Visperas of Barangay David, SK Chairperson Daisyree Aquino Bautista of Barangay Salaan and SK Kagawad Mary Ann E Quindara of Barangay Bantayan;

WHEREAS, their proposed PROJECT RESKYU aims to serve the community as emergency health responders; to be first aiders during health emergencies and natural disasters, and to deliver basic health care services;

WHEREAS, out of 22 LGU participants nine LGUs joined the project grant competition, and among these participants the SK Federation of Mangaldan bagged the second place and is the only representative of Region One in the said competition, winning Fifty Thousand Pesos (P50,000.00) financial grant;

WHEREAS, the SK Federation of Mangaldan is highly encouraged to institutionalize this project through policy and allocating budget for sustainability purposes;

WHEREAS, Mangaldan takes pride in this success of our Mangaldan youth leaders giving inspiration to the youth and even to youth organizations to ideate and implement relevant community projects;

WHEREAS, this accomplishment proves that these young emerging leaders and the Mangaldan youth in general are taking their part in building a stronger nation;



WHEREFORE, on motion of Councilor Aldrin O. Soriano duly seconded by all other members present:

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved that the *Sangguniang Bayan* of Mangaldan, Pangasinan commends the Sangguniang Kabataan Federation of Mangaldan for bagging second place out of nine Local Government Unit participants in the country in the SK YOUNIFIED 2.0 program project grant competition conducted by the National Movement of Young Legislators in partnership with the Young Southeast Asian Leaders Initiative and the United States Government Alumni Association Negros Occidental;


