RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING MUNICIPAL MAYOR HON. MARY MARILYN DG. LAMBINO TO REGULATE THE ENTRY OF LOCALLY STRANDED INDIVIDUALS (LSI) AND RETURNING OVERSEAS FILIPINOS (ROF) WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MANGALDAN, PANGASINAN TO CONTAIN THE SPREAD OF CORONAVIRUS DISEASE.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 16 of the Local Government Code, every local government unit has the implied power to do all things necessary, appropriate, or incidental to govern efficiently and effectively, promote general welfare, promote health and safety, maintain peace and order, and preserve the comfort and convenience of their inhabitants;

WHEREAS, President Rodrigo Roa Duterte issued Proclamation No. 922, entitled "Declaring a State of Public Health Emergency throughout the Philippines" due to the onslaught of COVID-19";

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 11469 or the "Bayanihan to Heal as One Act", declared a State of National Emergency over the entire country in view of the continuing rise of confirmed cases of COVID-19, the serious threat to the health,

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safety, security and lives of our countrymen, and the severe disruption of economic activities;

WHEREAS, Section 6 (e) of Republic Act No. 11332, "The Mandatory Reporting of Notifiable Diseases and Health Events of Public Health Concern Act", provides that the Local Governments have the authority to conduct and enforce disease surveillance and response system, epidemic/outbreak and epidemiologic investigations, and rapid containment, quarantine and isolation, DISEASE PREVENTION and control measures;

WHEREAS, we require the public to stay aware of the danger of COVID-19 disease, although for most people causes only mild illness, it can make some people very ill. More rarely, the disease can be fatal, older people, and those with pre-existing medical condition (high blood pressure, heart problem or diabetes) appear to be more vulnerable;

WHEREAS, the Local Government Unit is mandated to enforce stricter policy by regulating the entry of Locally Stranded Individual (LSI) and Returning Overseas Filipinos (ROF). Accordingly, the provisions of Executive Order No. 0033-2020 issued by the Provincial Governor, Hon. Amado I. Espino III, particularly Section 13, par. (B) on the Guidelines on the Management of LSIs and ROFs shall be taken into consideration, to wit:

No LSI or ROF shall be allowed to travel or shall be received by LGUs without the following required documents:

1. For LSIs:

- a. A Medical Clearance Certification issued by the respective City/Municipal Health Office on the following conditions:
 - i. That the LSI is neither a contact, suspect, or probable or confirmed COVID-19 case; and
 - ii. That the LSI completed a 14-day quarantine based on the quarantine standards set by the DOH; or
 - iii. That the LSI confirmed as a COVID-19 case was tested negative through the RT-PCR twice.
- b. Travel Authority issued by the JTF-CV Shield.

2. For ROFs:

- a. Negative RT-PCR result and Quarantine Certification issued by DOH-Bureau of Quarantine.
- b. Travel Authority issued by the JTF-CV Shield.;
- 3. A Certificate of Acceptance by the Receiving LGU is not a requirement on the management of LIS/ROFs. Only the above Medical Clearance Certification and Travel Authority shall be required.

WHEREAS, pursuant to the guidelines issued by the DILG and PNP, the Local Government Unit of Mangaldan, Pangasinan further requires (for reiteration purposes) the LSIs to secure the following documents for them to be accepted in the municipality, to wit:

- 1. 14-day Quarantine Completion Certificate issued by the Barangay;
- 2. Medical Clearance issued by the Municipal Health Office; and
- 3. Travel Authority issued by the Philippine National Police (PNP).;

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WHEREFORE, on motion of Councilor Dr. Joselito G. Quinto duly seconded by all remaining members present:

RESOLVED, as it is hereby resolved that the Sangguniang Bayan of Mangaldan, Pangasinan authorizes Hon. Mayor Mary Marilyn DG. Lambino to regulate the entry of Locally Stranded Individuals (LSI) and Returning Overseas Filipinos (ROF) within the Municipality of Mangaldan, Pangasinan to contain the spread of Coronavirus Disease;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that copies of this resolution be furnished the MLGOO, Mrs. Romarie P. Soriano, the Commission on Audit through Mrs. Marina P. De Guzman, Audit Team Leader, the Mangaldan PNP through PLTCOL Jun M Wacnag, Chief of Police, the MSWDO, Mrs. Rowena C. De Guzman, the Municipal Health Officer, Dr, Larry B. Sarito, the Office of the Municipal Mayor, Hon. Mary Marilyn DG. Lambino and all other authorities concerned for their information and favorable action.
